The Library has changed the way students, faculty and staff can access Library Resources from off campus. Users are now able to enter their WebDMC username and password to access Library resources from any internet-connected computer or device.

Access Services Reminders

Room Reservations—Please call ahead to reserve a room in the library (or call Stone Writing Center to reserve a room on the 4th).

Remember to complete the room survey and to cancel if plans change. It is better to tentatively schedule a room and confirm it later than to wait and not get the room you need. Available: large group room in 514; computer labs in 103 and 533; Room 212 and 506 are small meeting rooms; 530 is a movie theater. Those using the room must set it up for their needs.

If you require a film for class viewing, please request it well in advance of your anticipated viewing date. Otherwise, someone else may reserve it.

Audio/Visual Services (AV)—Although our AV services are limited, we will still deliver AV equipment around campus if you need it. Some of the equipment we can supply are: projectors, laptops, screens, televisions, VCR/DVD players.

The Library has a **Reserve Collection** for faculty to place materials students will need to succeed in their classes. If you would like to place a book or other item on reserve, you may do so at any time. We encourage faculty to place textbooks on Reserve, as students do not have funds to purchase books early in the semester. It does take some time at the beginning of the semester for your book or item to appear in the catalog. For more information call (361) 698-1310

College IDs are available at the Library, beginning a week before classes start. New students needing an ID may have one made at the Library 30 minutes after opening and before closing. Students must bring a photo ID to get their DMC ID. The first ID is free, but if it is lost or stolen, any replacements are \$5. Students who already have an ID may return to the Library to have their ID validated for the current semester.
