## Clinical RN Preceptors Wanted

### What is a Clinical RN Preceptor?

A licensed registered nurse who directly supervises clinical learning experiences for no more than two (2) students. A preceptor also assists in the evaluation of a student during the experiences and in acclimating the student to the role of nurse.

Clinical RN Preceptors stipend:  
\$96/day for each clinical day  
\$125/day after 1-3 years  
\$150/day 3+ years

### What qualifications are required to be a Clinical RN Preceptor?

- Currently practicing registered nurse in the State of Texas
- At least one-year of nursing practice in the clinical setting
- Exhibit competence in designated areas of practice
- Have a philosophy of health care congruent with that of the nursing program

### What are the Characteristics of a Clinical RN Preceptor?

- Knowledgeable
- Approachable
- Uses critical thinking skills
- Willing to teach others
- Empathetic to student learning capabilities
- Effective in communication with others
- Proficient in-patient care
- Proficient in computer skills

### What are the steps to become a Clinical RN Preceptor?

- Complete a 7-week course (14.0 contact hours) plus a 4 hour simulation (4.0 contact hours)
- Complete a clinical mentorship with DMC nursing faculty at your clinical site (6.0 contact hours)
- Independently serve in Clinical RN Preceptor Role
